AGREEMENT OF COOPERATION

between

ACCADEMIA DI BELLE ARTI DI NAPOLI - (ITALY)

and

UNIVERSITY OF ARTS TIRANA – (ALBANIA)

Accademia di Belle Arti di Napoli (ABANA), based in Naples, via S.Maria di Costantinopoli 107/A, represented by the Director Professor Giuseppe Gaeta

and

University of Arts Tirana, based in Tirana, Albania, Bulevardi “Dëshmorët e Kombit”, Sheshi “Nënë Tereza”, Nr. 2, 1019, represented by the Rector, Prof. Dr. Erald Bakalli.

Set up the following:

Art. 1.

Accademia di Belle Arti di Napoli and University of Arts Tirana by drawing up this agreement mean:

- to promote and develop actions, projects and common intents to improve the mutual knowledge of the culture and society of the two countries.

- to develop the artistic and professional competences of the teaching in all the periods of study, as well as the development of new profiles of operators, with special regards to the preservation of cultural assets, artistic design for enterprises and new technologies of art.
- to facilitate forms of national and international cooperation between academies to carry out didactic and research projects of excellence.

Art.2.

In order to the aims of art.1 the above-mentioned Institutions work out, by mutual agreement, every year a plan of work and exchange, setting costs and providing to guarantee, in equal measure, the interests of both of them.

To achieve the general and specific goals established in art. 1, the subjects of this agreement undertake to fulfill proper actions hereafter listed:

- exchanges of students and professors;
- planning and carrying out of commons curricula;
- commons courses of study for Masters;
- education and retraining for professors even through advanced technologies;
- drawing, carrying out, experimentation of innovative teaching materials;
- courses of lectures, seminars, workshops, speaking tours even through advanced technologies;
- specific counseling activity;
- development of relations with other Fine Arts Academies;
- development of relations with private and public subjects who work in the field of art in Italy and Albania to fulfill work experiences for students;
- cultural activities in the artistic, theatrical, musical, cinematographic, scientific field;
- participation to academic cooperation projects promoted by local Departments or other supranational agencies;
- promoting of activities;
- every other activity that will be considered relevant for the achievement of the goals of this agreement;

Art.3.

The subjects (professors, experts, students) involved in the progress of the activities listed in this agreement must take out a casualty and third-party insurance, in the case of accidents happened during the execution of the activities mentioned in this agreement. The insurance costs will be paid by the relative Institution of reference.

Art.4.

To draw up this agreement the every of two Institutions appoint its own representative.

The two representatives have the task of doing the activity plan and the relative budget plan and at the end of the projects, to check the achievement of the expected goals.

The representative for Accademia di Belle Arti di Napoli is the Director, Prof. Giuseppe Gaeta.

The representative for University of Arts Tirana is Assoc. Prof. Albes Fusha.

Art.5.




